And whereas for the better protection of the Government, the obligor has agreed to execute this bond with such condition as hereunder is written.

Now the condition of the above written obligation is that in the event of my failing to resume duty, resigning or retiring from or otherwise quitting service without returning to duty after the expiry or termination of the period of study leave so extended or any time within a period of three years after his return to duty, the obligor and the sureties shall forthwith pay to the Government or as may be directed by the Government on demand the said sum of Rs.(.Rupees only) together with interest thereon from the date of demand at Government rates for the time being in force on Government loans.

And upon making such payment the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue :

The bond shall in all respects be governed by the laws of the J&K State for the time being in force and the rights and liabilities here under shall where necessary be accordingly determined by the appropriate courts.
